#### PRINCIPALS NEWS...

#### **Developing School Wide Positive Behaviours (SWPBS)**

Over the last term, we have established the practice of providing feedback on positive behaviours. Gotchas are now well entrenched and recognise student individual positive behaviour. This term all classrooms also have some sort of collective recognition of positive behaviours. Some classes are using marble/cotton wool jars while others are using a point system with awards for achieving the class goal.

In reviewing our SWPBS processes, we have identified the need to provide more timely consequences where students are guided to improve their behaviour choices.

Starting Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017, the School will be implementing a 15-minute time out/make up session during lunch. This allows teachers to provide timely consequences for major behaviour incidents. This time out session

will also include students making up time lost due to being sent to another classroom/time out in the classroom or being sent to the office. Students that are sent to the office more than once in a week or repeatedly being asked to leave the classroom will attend Friday after school detention. During these time-out sessions or after-school detention, the students will participate in a discussion outlining strategies they will use to move towards more positive behaviours. Parents will be notified on class dojo if their child has been placed in time out. Furthermore, parents will be informed in writing if their child has been placed on Friday after school detention.

We look forward to continuing the development of positive behaviours in the school.



Please note that YouTube has many positive educational uses. However, there is content on YouTube that may be inappropriate for seemingly harmless searches. In the past, we have only allowed the use of YouTube under teacher supervision. In reviewing procedure, we have decided to not allow students to use YouTube at school while we figure out how we can develop stronger controls on content etc. We strongly recommend parents supervise their children closely if they are using YouTube at home. We also recommend for parents to set up parental controls for YouTube.
