Congratulations to all those students who participated in the Lightning Premiership this week. They truly represented our school values of Respect, Responsibility and Integrity!

### Interesting Information

This week, we received information regarding traffic in Wills Cres from the City of Greater Geelong.....

*“Traffic classifiers (“road counters”) were placed on Wills Crescent between 29 August to 16 September 2016 to collect vehicle speed and volume data.*

*The data shows the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile (the behaviour of 85% of drivers) are exceeding the posted speed limit by >16% on Wills Crescent which is a Category 2 Road.*

*Due to the driver behaviour of the 85th percentile this street qualifies for traffic calming works.....Another way residents can help reduce poor driver behaviour in an area is to report inconsiderate road users (hoons) to the police. The Police can be contacted via the Road Safety Hotline (anonymously if you wish) on 1800 333 000. Please state the days and times that these events typically occur. If you observe dangerous driving, you can call 000 for immediate Police assistance”.*

Let's keep our streets safe for students.
