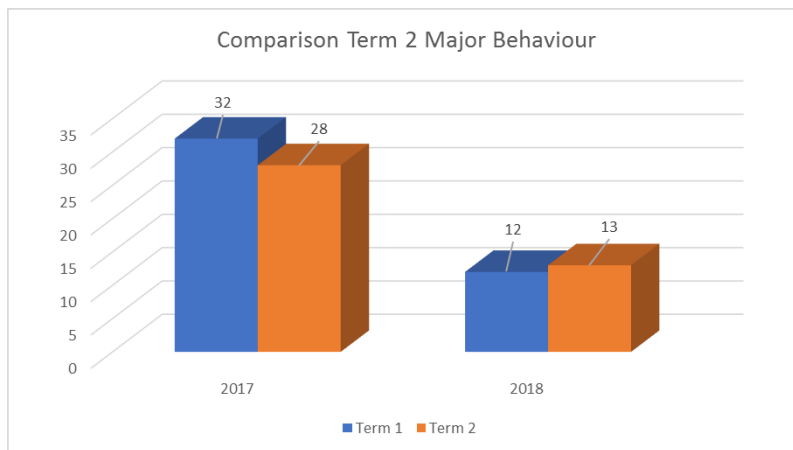


PRINCIPALS NEWS...

School Goal Progress

This year we are focusing specifically on developing student reading and our practices around SWPBS. The key to developing these areas is incorporating student voice and agency. We want students to be able to contribute to discussions around their learning and take responsibility for achieving the goals they set collaboratively with their teacher. Over the next few weeks the staff will be reviewing Reading Data and developing plans for learning for next semester. This will culminate with a **Curriculum Day on Friday 29th June**.

In SWPBS, we have made significant shifts in our culture towards promoting positive behaviours. There are many anecdotal examples indicating this shift. One is with Prep students frequently complimenting one another on positive behaviours instead of pointing out to teachers what other students are doing wrong. The comparison chart below also provides insights to significant improvements our students are making in the way they behave. There is always more work to be done but this is a real positive progress.
