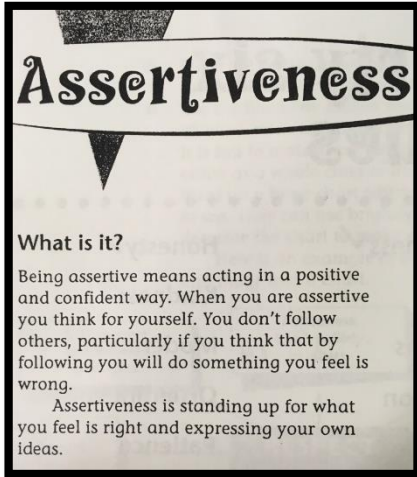
## Reminder
