ADMIN MATTERS... WORKING WITH CHILDREN

School Council met last week and reviewed a number of school policies including Visitors, Volunteers and Working with Children. A reminder that ALL volunteers at Moolap PS are required to have a current WWC check. Please ensure that you provide a copy to the office for their records. Below is a copy of the Department's regulations -

The WWC Check is a minimum checking standard set by the Working with Children Act2005 for those who work with children, either on a paid or voluntary basis.

To be a volunteer at a school a Working with Children Card provided by the Department of Justice is required. This card is:

- valid for 5 years
- transferable between volunteer organisations
- free of charge for volunteers, but cannot be used for paid employment.
